

**Sanitation
Trash Schedule & Guidelines**

- Trash is collected once a week: Friday morning is Whittington Commons' collection day.
- Attach a yellow trash \$2 sticker around the handle of each 35-gal. container or the neck of each bag.
- Crews start work at 5 a.m., so place trash bags or containers by the curb the night before pickup. Do not place containers out more than 24 hours in advance and remove them from the curb on the same day as pick up. Violation may result in a fine up to \$50. Each day a violation continues is a separate violation.
- Non collectible items include: tires, automobile parts, car bodies, dirt, ashes, liquids, construction materials, hazardous wastes, toxic materials, infections waste, asbestos, liquid sludge, radioactive wastes, industrial wastes, computers and televisions.
- As an alternative to curbside pickup, most residential and commercial garbage, furniture and construction/demolition debris may be taken to Hoosier Disposal: 6660 South Old State Road 37-824-7998.
- New residents are encouraged to contact the Public Works Dept. at 349-3410 regarding specific trash collection day and recycling collection dates.

Purchase Trash Stickers Description

City trash stickers cost \$2 each and yard waste stickers \$1 each. The following vendors currently sell City Trash and Yard Waste Stickers. Vendors in bold also sell paper yard waste bags.

Recycling Services Description

Every other week on your regular trash day, recycling services is provided free of charge to recipients of City trash pickup.

Participants are asked to sort their recyclables into 2 categories:

1. Paper Products

(which must be dry) including mixed office paper, newspaper, cardboard and paper board. Boxes must be flattened.

2. Metal Cans, Glass Containers, and Plastic Bottles

Including metal food and beverage cans, glass jars and bottles, plastic bottles #1 and #2 only.

Containers, bottles and cans must be rinsed out, and the lids removed. Labels do not need to be removed.

One official Bloomington recycling bin will be issued to each residence. Other similarly sized, privately purchased containers may be used. Sort each category into a separate bin or paper sack and leave bin (s) on curb the evening before your scheduled pickup day.
